GiESCO (formerly GESCO) was launched 39 years ago by professor Alain Carbonneau. Today, the organization gathers a deep expertise in a large range of viticulture sectors, including genetics and breeding, vine and grape physiology, pests and diseases, soil science, canopy management, terroir and climate and is open to any contribution to the understanding of the global viticultural system. Every 2 years, the association organizes an international meeting to share new knowledge and scientific/technological perspectives and analyze the needs from industry and society.
